The Combined Federal Campaign (CFC) supports and promotes philanthropy through a program that is employee-focused, cost-efficient, and cost-effective. CFC provides all federal employees the unique opportunity to improve the quality of life for everyone.

Established by Executive Order in 1961, the CFC continues to be the largest and most successful annual workplace fundraising model in the world.

In 1961, seeing a need to bring the diversity of fundraising efforts under one umbrella, Federal employees created the CFC – one campaign, once a year, each Fall. By allowing employees to select from a single guide and making their contributions through payroll deductions, the CFC opened the door to more opportunities for generosity by giving to literally thousands of worthy causes.

Employee Benefits

The CFC belongs to you, the federal employee. The CFC does not belong to the federal government and its agencies, or the charitable organizations.

Federal employees can utilize the convenience of payroll deduction. Payroll deduction facilitates your charitable giving by having a small amount deducted each payroll period.

You can direct your support to charities that provide services to people and at the same time know what percentage is spent on fundraising and overhead costs.

Federal employees annually review all listed charities ensuring that only those meeting high standards participate in the CFC.

For 50 years the CFC has a proven record of effectiveness and efficiency.
